The Cottage:

- The cottage was built in 1985.
- It is 1 1/2 story with approximately 1500 square feet of space.
- *Non-smoking.*
- Pets welcome (see Terms and Conditions).

Cottage Features:

- 1 indoor bathroom with shower (bathmat provided), 1 two piece outdoor bathroom, 4 bedrooms (1 Queen, 2 doubles, 1 single, all with pillows and bedspreads), living room, country kitchen, and large back entry room.
- Large, 2 level deck.
- Upper level deck off master bedroom with view of lake.
- Canoe, paddle boat, row boat, and kayak use included.
 - Some life jackets available; bring your own to ensure proper fit.

Modern conveniences:

- Fridge/freezer, stove, dishwasher (dishwasher detergent provided), microwave, coffee maker (filters provided), fully equipped kitchen, BBQ, clothes dryer, central vacuum, radio with CD and tape player, DVD player.
- Game/puzzle cupboard for rainy day or evening fun.
- Wood stove and electric heat.
- Well water (tested yearly and includes drinking water system).
- Septic system.

The Cottage Property

- A private southwest exposure to the lake with over 450 feet of water frontage.
 - You have a whole point of the lake to yourself.
- Ample parking.
- Heavily treed lot with privacy.
- Sun access all day if desired.

- Short walk to dock.
- Large floating dock with swimming ladder.
- Jump into 7 feet of water right off the dock.

The Lake

- Robertson Lake is roughly 8.2 km, with a maximum depth of 30.5 meters. Common fish found in the lake are Northern Pike, Smallmouth and Largemouth Bass.
- It has 13 islands and is 110 feet deep at its south end and 15 feet at the north. It is reputed to be the 3rd cleanest lake in Ontario.
- The lake is spring-fed and great for all water sports.
- Equipped with a public boat launch, Robertson Lake can handle everything from Personal Water Craft to ski and pontoon boats. You will also see many kayaks and canoes. For the most part, the lake is very quiet, with activity picking up on a hot afternoon. Fishing is popular.
- The lake has a beautiful park at the north end, with a baseball field, beach, diving dock, and picnic grounds. A smaller beach is located closer to our cottage at the south end of the lake.
